~ Jesus is Tempted

Matthew 4:1-11

Weekly Scripture: We have a great High priest who has gone into heaven. He is Jesus the Son of God. So let us hold on to the faith we have. For our high priest is able to understand our weaknesses. When he lived on earth, he was tempted in every way that we are, but he did not sin.

Hebrews 4:14-15 (ICB)

- Locate a verse in the Bible that will help your child with an area he is tempted in. Remind him that even Jesus used God's Word to help keep Him from giving into temptation.

March 13, 2022

~ Jesus Walks on the Water

Matthew 14:22-33

Weekly Scripture: After Peter and Jesus were in the boat, the wind became calm. Then those who were in the boat worshipped Jesus and said, "Truly you are the Son of God!"

Matthew 14:32-33 (ICB)

I asked the Lord for help, and he answered me. He saved me from all that I feared.

Psalms 34:4 (ICB)

- Memorize Psalm 34:4 together. Talk about how scripture not only helps us avoid temptation but it also helps us to keep our eyes on Jesus. Consider how worshipping Him and going to church are also good ways to keep our sights on God's Son, Jesus.

March 20, 2022

~ Jesus Shines!

Matthew 17:1-9

Weekly Scriptures: Jesus heard the voice of God, the Greatest Glory. That was when Jesus received honor and glory from God the Father. The voice said, "This is my Son, and I love him. I am very pleased with him." We heard that voice. It came from heaven while we were with Jesus on the holy mountain.

II Peter 1:17-18 (ICB)

- Discuss the brightest light you have ever seen. Was it a spot light or maybe the sun? How do you imagine God's glory compares to it?

March 27, 2022

~ Jesus Raises Lazarus from the Dead

John 11:1-44

Weekly Scriptures: When Jesus heard this he said, "This sickness will not end in death. It is for the glory of God. This had happened to bring glory to the Son of God.

John 11: 4 (ICB)

We know that in everything God works for the good of those who love him.

Romans 8:28a (ICB)

- Share a difficult situation that you have been through. Did it seem like maybe God had forgotten you? How was God's power and glory ultimately shown in that situation? Pray with your child about something difficult she is facing reminding her that God's timing is always perfect.



A Note to Parents: Understanding that Jesus truly is God's Son is a key concept. He wasn't just another man. He was the Son of God who came to this earth to save us! In the process of being on this earth He also taught us some valuable things. He demonstrated His Father's power and glorified God.

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
